RoHS means "Restriction of the use of certain Hazardous Substances in electric and electronic equipment"

The objectives are to facilitate electronic and electric equipment recycling

Substances concerned

4 heavy metals:

- lead
- cadmium
- hexavalent chromium
- mercury

2 brominated flame retardancies:

- PBB (Polybrominated biphenyls)
- PBDE (Polybrominated diphenyl ether)

Equipment concerned

- · Big domestic appliances
- Small domestic appliances
- Data processing and telecommunication equipment
- Consumer equipment
- Lighting
- Electric and electronic tools
- Toys, leisure and sport equipment
- Vending machines
