RoHS means *“Restriction of the use of certain Hazardous Substances in electric and electronic equipment”*

The objectives are to facilitate electronic and electric equipment recycling

◀ Substances concerned

4 heavy metals :

- lead
- cadmium
- hexavalent chromium
- mercury

2 brominated flame retardancies :

- PBB (Polybrominated biphenyls)
- PBDE (Polybrominated diphenyl ether)

◀ Equipment concerned

- Big domestic appliances
- Small domestic appliances
- Data processing and telecommunication equipment
- Consumer equipment
- Lighting
- Electric and electronic tools
- Toys, leisure and sport equipment
- Vending machines

◀ Our commitment

Although our items are not included in the field of application, Dickson PTL checks that all chemical products used for coated fabrics **do not contain noncompliant substances or contain only in rates inferior to authorized limits** (0.1% for heavy metals and 0.01% for polybrominated).
